New source of electricity data

A new on-line service providing electricity market information is being launched at the National Power Conference.

Energy Market Services (EMS) is launching its new web based service to publish a broad range of market information. The EMS Information eXchange, 'em⁶', provides a consolidated source of electricity operational and market related data.

em⁶ provides a comprehensive view of the electricity market with tools that enable users to analyse and model different aspects of the market. Examples include; real-time trading analysis, industry trends and situations post analysis, transmission and market modelling, exposure to the spot market analysis and coincident peak demand analysis.

"This is the first time that retailers, generators and major electricity users have been able to readily access a wide variety of energy information from a single source." says EMS CEO Kevin Duckworth. "The em⁶ website makes it easy to view and download what you want, including near real time data. Plus, you can customise your view and set up web services to automatically receive key data daily, or even half hourly."

EMS has already identified a number of innovative enhancements for em⁶, including displaying real time price information in a geographical format.

em⁶ will go live at www.em6.co.nz at the end of March.
