New electricity information website launched

Transpower announced today that its subsidiary company Energy Market Services (EMS) has launched a new informative electricity site www.em6live.co.nz that allows greater accessibility to NZ electricity market data.

em⁶ live is a free service and is a further enhancement to EMS's current electricity information suite which includes the subscriber-based em⁶.

EMS Chief Executive Kevin Duckworth said that the new website is a collaborative effort between Transpower and EMS to help make electricity data more user-friendly and understandable for those who are interested in how the current electricity market is operating.
